The resource group enables localized chapters promoting various programs such as tips for plastic use reduction, EV charging stations in company parking lots, and on-site greenhouses and gardening spaces dedicated to donating produce to local foodbanks.

Additionally in Canada, the company has piloted device recycling programs for years, preventing over 10,000 devices each year from ending up in landfills.

Since 2014, Medtronic's global operations has consistently published annual reports highlighting its ongoing sustainability efforts, aiming for carbon neutrality by 2030 and net-zero carbon emissions by 2045.

From small daily actions to enterprise level changes, Medtronic's environmental commitment is part of the fabric of its corporate Mission to alleviate pain, restore health and extend life.
